- Bluegrass Concert - Lion Bob Martin provided update on Bluegrass concert that meeting on Thursday, Sept 24th at 11am to get a funding update. Lion Maureen and Frank Kinald provided update that posters were well received by businesses on the Square. Sales are running behind last year, but hope that longer calling timeline and expansion to Round Rock market will expand Sales.
- Lion Weldon Wade won a Club drawing at the meeting to have responsibility for maintaining our new eyeglass collection box on the Square.
- Blood Drive - Lion Gerald Pohlmeyer updated that our Blood Drive starts this week – Sept 23, 24, 25 at Wolfe Ranch location. Additional brochures were made available from Lion Gerald.
- Memorial at District Convention - Lion Frank Kinald provided status update that he has submitted our Club to provide memorial at District Convention. Awaiting word on what we will be asked to do.
- Lions/Sertoma Joint Health Screening - Lion Frank Kinald is providing Secretary support for District MERL and Charities teams. We can get screening equipment in the Spring. Discussed how we might provide best access for Community, involve healthcare professionals in the area, get training on equipment, and timing (steer clear of holidays). Want to get it done during School Year. Group will continue to explore what can be done.
