District 2-S3 Diabetes Awareness Chair, Lion Beverly Verlinde. President of the Lake Travis Club and District Awareness Chair (2nd year). Diabetes is increasing dramatically and many don’t know they have it. Eating incorrectly and lack of exercise contribute. Diabetes can cause blindness, heart attack, stroke and amputations. US has approximately 86,000 diabetes amputations a year. Also a contributor to kidney failure. Fatigue, hypoglycemia (not paying attention to sugar levels). Blood work should be done every six months to get your blood sugar levels. Any score over 120 is considered pre-diabetic. Watch “white” intake – white bread, white pasta. Carbs turn to sugar. Diabetes can be inherited, so families need to stay informed. Pamphlets shared with Club members and all encouraged to stay aware of their health.
