- Lion Carol Hopper – Georgetown Noon Club raffle - \$2/ticket. Condo prize, Xbox & Kinect and drill. Tickets they have been selling.
- Note from Lion Maureen Kinald. Update that Leo Club is off to slow start. Will try to start things up after the first of the year.
- Audit Report – pending Lion Maureen Kinald and Lion Kristin Kinald's formal update.
- Question around usage of 27 students, can we drive up participation. Lion Martha Woodley to reach to Lion Susan Hopper from the Georgetown Noon Club to be a possible speaker at a future club meeting.

Treasurer's Report – Lion Randy Woodley

- Lion Randy provided an overview of the Charitable and Administrative accounts.
- Motion to accept as presented – Lion Adrien Drouihlet, second Lion Kristin Kinald, approved.

Program – Lion Kristin Kinald

- 2nd Vice-District Governor Frank Kinald – sharing his experience at the Lions Leadership Institute in Chicago.
- Senior Lions Leadership Training Institute. Long days of training. Mentoring, Conflict Resolution, Presentation Skills, Project Mgt and many other topics. If you are over a 2nd Vice-District Governor you cannot attend. Limited to 100 attendees.
- Lion Frank was part of a team in advance of the Forum with leaders from all over. Team prepared in advance for session on-site.
- Typical Session - Presentations, Case Studies, Discussions. After multiple sessions throughout the day. Group study at the end of the day. 96 other Lions from around the US, but one from New Zealand as well!
- Seven (7) similar leadership sessions held around the world.
- Worked on elevator pitch of what is Lions. More focus on retention of members. Estimates that 50% of new Lions leaving in their first two years.
- 22,000 northern Lions retired and relocated to the south, but only 5,000 joined clubs. Losing members because we're not tracking them.
- Project Management training. 5 teams, 5 different answers. No right answer.
- Communications – example, proper use of email.
- Effective speaking – Given assignment when they arrived on Friday to provide two minute speech.
- Conflict resolution – Resources available to assist at District and Club level.
- Diversity – appreciating different personalities in Clubs.
- One stop resource “cheat sheet” provided.
